The couple who owns the property is English, which means that in addition to wonderful hospitality, the breakfasts were much better than your usual French B&B breakfast fare. Their golden retriever, Phoebe, will also do her best to make you feel welcome. The property is only a 5-minute drive from the center of Morlaix, or you can take a path if you're going by foot that only take about 10-15 minutes. In fact, if you're just looking for a peaceful getaway, you could take the train to Morlaix and spend the entire weekend at the Manoir and in Morlaix and not bother renting a car. There are, however, a number of places to see in the area that require a car, so do rent a car if you are able.

Fri, Sept 3 - Sat, Sept 4	Morlaix	<p>Manoir de Coat Amour</p> <p>I arrived Friday in time for dinner in Morlaix and a walk around the old center. Saturday, we drove to the pleasant town of Le Faou, then to Pen Hir in Finistère. From the point at Pen Hir, we took a wonderful loop walk (about 3 hours) along the coast (along the GR34, one of the long distance trails in France), by old WWII bunkers, and back through the town of Camaret. The coastline in this region is spectacular. We then visited the picturesque town of Locronan where we enjoyed an oyster dinner before heading back to Morlaix.</p>
Sun, Sept 5	Morlaix Night at Abby's in Paris	<p>We had all day in Sunday before heading back to Paris. We drove through the beautiful village of Le Yaudet (including a morning snack of blackberries, which are plentiful in early September). Then we went on to Ploumanach on the Côte du Granit Rose (the Pink Granite Coast), a picturesque seaside village.
