PARIS WEEKENDER'S HALF-DAY PARIS ITINERARIES: <u>THE 3RD ARRONDISSEMENT</u>



- 1. Start just north of the Pompidou Center on rue Rambuteau and follow it and its continuation, rue des Francs Bourgeois, east, enjoying the shops and cafés.
- 2. Peek in the courtyards of the National Archives and the Musée Carnavalet, both on the north side of the street.
- If you have not already done so in your exploration of the 4th arrondissement, stop to visit the Place des Vosges (rue des Francs Bourgeois forms the northern side of the colonnaded square.)
- 4. Follow rue de Turenne north then left on rue de Bretagne (or detour left down rue de Poitou first for some alluring boutiques). Off the southern side of rue de Bretagne is the Marché des Enfants Rouges, where you can buy food products or sit and eat at one of the many eateries representing cuisines from around the world. Or for something a bit fancier, try Moroccan food at Le 404 (69 rue des Gravilliers, Tel: 01 42 71 20 38).
- 5. If you have extra time, spend some time wandering around the smaller streets north of rue de Bretagne. This is a part of the Northern Marais with a real neighborhood feeling and not as touristy as the Southern Marais.
