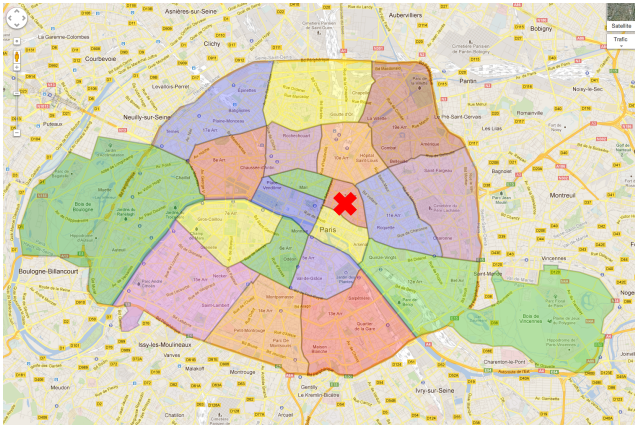


# PARIS WEEKENDER'S HALF-DAY PARIS ITINERARIES: THE 3<sup>RD</sup> ARRONDISSEMENT



1. Start just north of the **Pompidou Center** on rue Rambuteau and follow it and its continuation, **rue des Frangs Bourgeois**, east, enjoying the shops and cafés.
2. Peek in the courtyards of the **National Archives** and the **Musée Carnavalet**, both on the north side of the street.
3. If you have not already done so in your exploration of the 4<sup>th</sup> arrondissement, stop to visit the **Place des Vosges** (rue des Frangs Bourgeois forms the northern side of the colonnaded square.)
4. Follow rue de Turenne north then left on **rue de Bretagne** (or detour left down **rue de Poitou** for some alluring boutiques). Off the southern side of rue de Bretagne is the **Marché des Enfants Rouges**, where you can buy food products or sit and eat at one of the many eateries representing cuisines from around the world. Or for something a bit fancier, try Moroccan food at **Le 404** (69 rue des Gravilliers, Tel: 01 42 71 20 38).

5. If you have extra time, spend some time wandering around the **smaller streets north of rue de Bretagne**. This is a part of the Northern Marais with a real neighborhood feeling and not as touristy as the Southern Marais.
